

Scan the Set Connection Barcode

Once Windows installs the Bluetooth drivers you should see a Bluetooth icon in your System Tray. Double click on the icon and the image below should appear:




Click the options tab. Place check marks in ALL boxes as shown below. Then click apply and ok



Click on the Add button. The screen below will display.


Click the devices tab. Click the add button as shown below:




Place a check mark in the box that says My Device is set up and ready to be found. Click Next



Press and hold the trigger until the device populates:


