

Windows XP firewall exceptions for InventoryControl:

Programs: InventoryControl.exe, WasplInventoryWindowsService.exe, sqlservr.exe and sqlbrowser.exe

1. Open Windows Firewall by pressing the **Windows key** and the **R key** at the same time to launch the command window. Type **Control Panel** and click **OK**. Then click **Windows Firewall**.
2. Select the **Exceptions** tab. If the program is not in the Programs and Services: list, click **Add Program**.
3. If the program is not in the Programs: list click **Browse** to browse and select the program then click **Open**.

Default application locations:

C:\Program Files\Wasp Technologies\ InventoryControl\ InventoryControl.exe

C:\Program Files\Wasp Technologies\InventoryControl\Services\WasplInventoryWindowsService.exe

C:\Program Files\Microsoft SQL Server\90\Shared\sqlbrowser.exe

C:\Program Files\Microsoft SQL Server\MSSQL\$WASPDB\Binn\sqlservr.exe

* On the 64 bit OS go to C:\Program Files (x86).

4. The exception is added when the program is checked in the Programs and Services list:.
5. Click **OK** when finished.

Ports: 10004, 10005 and 1433.

1. Open Windows Firewall by pressing the **Windows key** and the **R key** at the same time to launch the command window. Type **Control Panel** and click **OK**. Then click **Windows Firewall**.
2. Select the **Exceptions** tab. If the program is not in the Programs and Services: list click **Add Port**.
3. Type the port number in the **Name:** and **Port number:** text boxes.
4. Select **TCP** and click **OK**
